It is proposed to prepare and publish a CCE half-yearly magazine by the Academic Cell, O/o of CCE. The magazine is compiled with articles, write-up poems, book reviews, start-up ideas, data survey reports, findings useful to the community, quality initiatives of CCE, initiatives of the institutions, intellectual property rights (IPR), patents, research publications, etc., by the students and staff. - a) The topic of the article should be of general interest, however, more emphasis may be given to academic initiatives.
- b) Articles acceptance/ rejection for publication depends on the decision of the committee
- c) The article's length may be limited to 3,000 words.
- d) Review (not exceeding 5000 words)
- e) News and Views (not exceeding 1000 words)
- f) The editors scrutinize the received articles for publication.
- g) CCE, Principals of GDCs and staff are the members of the committee.
- h) Articles screened by committees
- i) Articles for the first half-year sent on or before June 31st 2023 and the second half-year on or before December 31st 2023
